
In those days John the Baptist appeared in the wilderness of Judea, proclaiming,

Leader: Christian, what do you believe about the Incarnation?

All: We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten from the Father before all ages, God from God, Light from Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father; by whom all things were made; who for us and for our salvation came down from heaven; and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary, he was made man

SURSUM CORDA

Minister: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.
Minister: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them up to the Lord.

Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. All: It is right to give him thanks and praise.
